CPR and First Aid

You must attend all 8 hours of CPR and First Aid to be certified. This class meets basic health and safety training requirements for informal/unregulated child care providers. CPR and First Aid have limited availability; so please **Register Early!**

The trainings are free and limited to providers receiving child care subsidies through CAPS. Informal/unregulated child care providers may earn up to eight (8) credit hours of Georgia state-accepted training in one day to meet their annual training requirements. Family child care providers, however, may only receive six (6) credit hours of Georgia state-accepted training in one day. The sessions below may be taken separately to meet individual training needs. Pre-registration is required. No on-site registrations will be accepted. We love kids, but unfortunately we cannot accommodate infants and children at these trainings. If you bring your child(ren), we will ask you to leave and reschedule your training.

Informal/unregulated child care providers may satisfy the CAPS annual requirement of 8 state-accepted training hours by taking those hours in one day. Family child care providers, required by Bright from the Start to have a minimum of 10 state-accepted training hours annually, should be aware that no more than 6 of those 10 credit hours may be earned in any one day. The two-hour sessions may be taken separately to meet individual training needs. The sessions being offered meet Health and Safety training requirements.

Each participant will receive resource materials and will have the opportunity to win a \$25 gift certificate.
